Evaluation

The overall goal of this rotation is to provide students with an intense experience in caring for acutely ill children who have a wide range of ages, diseases, and cultures. Care of both the physical and psychosocial aspects of the patient's illness are emphasized and addressed. The rotation will assist any future pediatrician in recognizing and managing natural sequel of acute medical and surgical diseases, as well as potential complications and exacerbations of chronic illnesses.

Objectives:

- 1. To develop a systematic method of examining, assessing, presenting, and managing hospitalized patients.
- 2. To achieve proficiency in the recognition and initial management of problems commonly encountered on the pediatric floor.
- 3. To explain the multisytem medical, surgical, and psychosocial management of the acutely ill patients that the acting intern is caring for.
- 4. To recognize clinical deterioration and the need for more intensive care.
