Mind-body techniques can soothe stress of chemotherapy

Holistic medicine increasingly is becoming an integrative aspect of cancer care.

Breathing techniques, aromatherapy, progressive muscle relaxation, guided imagery or visualization, meditation, yoga, tai chi and even listening to music can help to soothe the anxiety, fear and worry associated with chemotherapy and other treatments.

Coping with chemotherapy can feel overwhelming. Stress causes muscle tension, a rapid heart rate, elevated blood pressure, fast breathing, as well as feelings of apprehension, irritation and frustration. When facing new treatment procedures, stress levels may rise and can then aggravate some of the potential side effects of treatment including nausea, fatigue and low energy. A relaxed state of mind and body can lessen the likelihood of such side effects. Patients can create a sense of control over their situations and develop more peaceful emotional states.



Quick Comeback

When Deborah Horseman discovered she needed surgery, she wanted the most effective procedure that would require the least amount of recuperation. The 59-year-old secretary had been diagnosed with colon cancer that would ultimately require the removal of 15 inches of her colon, and she was ready to have the surgery and get back to her busy career.

Deborah's physician, Daniel Otchy, MD, a colon and rectal surgeon, performed a robotic left colectomy, a minimally invasive procedure that results in a dramatically faster recovery than open surgery. Just three days after the procedure, which was performed at Inova Fair Oaks Hospital, Deborah went home and was able to walk and have normal bowel function. Only three weeks after the surgery, she was back to her normal activities.

Express Healing

"With robotic surgery, we use very small incisions and most patients have a rapid recovery," says Dr. Otchy. "Patients are in the hospital usually three or four days after a robotic procedure as opposed to five or six days with open surgery."

Deborah is pleased with her results. "I am very, very happy with the procedure," she says. "Dr. Otchy is wonderful. He explained everything from the get-go and he was very matter-of-fact. He's one of those very personable doctors who has a great bedside manner."

IT'S IN THE HIP

Innovative approach to hip replacement speeds healing

If you're considering a hip replacement but are concerned about a lengthy recovery, an advanced new procedure may provide the answer you're looking for. The medical team at the nationally recognized Inova Fair Oaks Hospital Joint Replacement Program now performs anterior hip replacement, a less invasive approach that allows you to get back on your feet soon after surgery.

"In the long-term, patients with both anterior and posterior approach hip replacement do great," says James Reeves, MD, an orthopedic surgeon at Inova Fair Oaks Hospital. "The advantages of the anterior approach are that the recovery tends to be quicker and there's a decreased risk of dislocation afterwards."

BIG STRIDES

Anterior hip replacement is an advanced, specialized procedure that involves a small incision on the front of the hip area to avoid disrupting muscles surrounding the joint.

"With anterior hip replacement, we see patients walking the day of surgery without any major disruption to their gait and some are even able to go home the next day," says Karen DuTeil, RN, MSN, ONC, orthopedic patient care navigator at the Inova Fair Oaks Hospital Joint Replacement Program. A team of highly skilled professionals, including orthopedic surgeons, a dedicated nursing staff, physical therapists and case managers supports the program.

Your doctor may recommend hip replacement surgery for a variety of reasons. Patients who benefit have the following conditions:

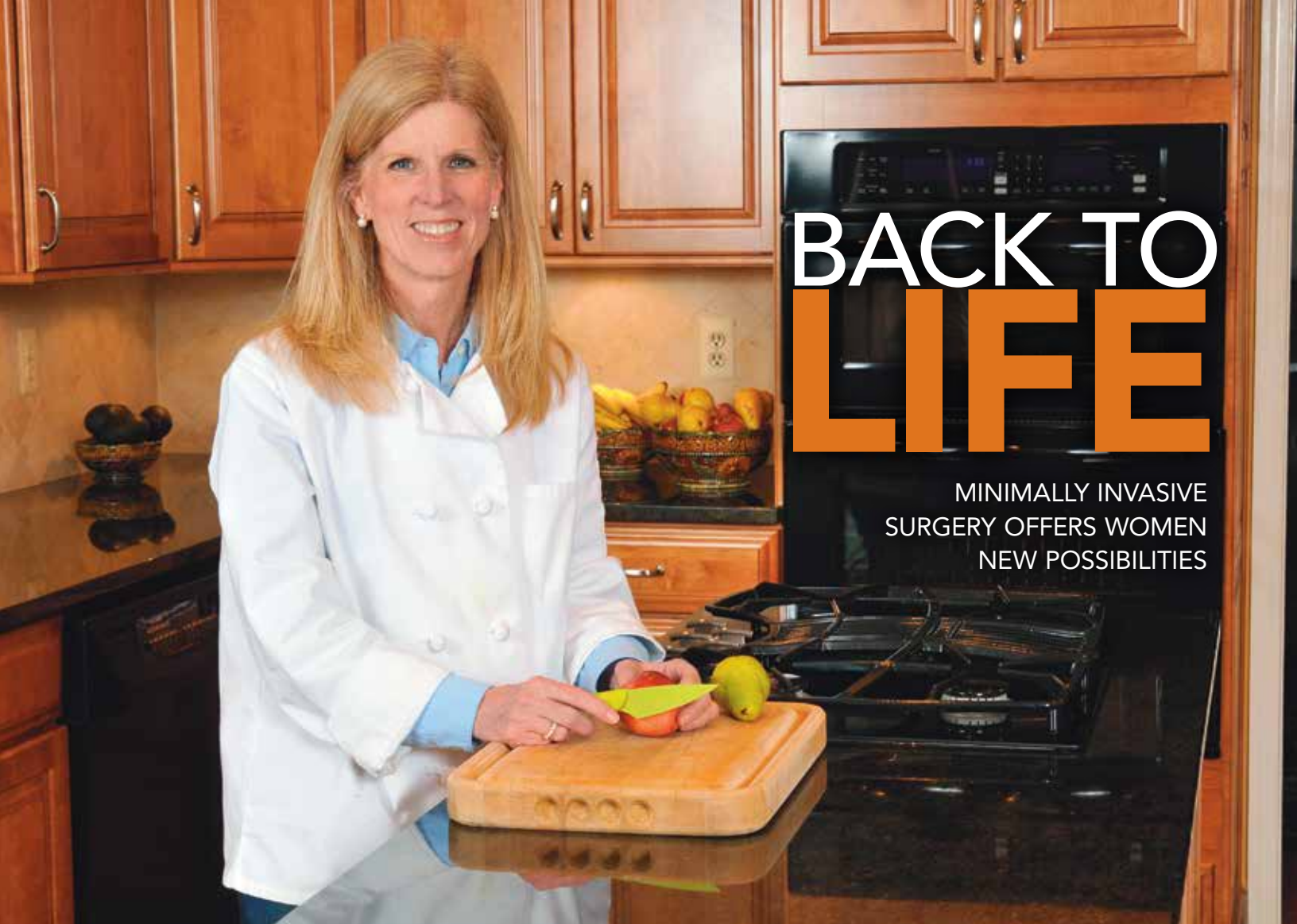
- Hip pain that limits everyday activities, such as walking or bending

MINIMALLY INVASIVE SURGERY OFFERS WOMEN NEW POSSIBILITIES

Inova Fair Oaks Hospital has been named a Center of Excellence in Minimally Invasive Gynecology by the AAGL, the leading association promoting minimally invasive gynecologic surgery. This prestigious award represents a five-year journey with one goal in mind: to improve the center’s already exceptional healthcare services for women.

“The process of achieving this award has helped our team assess and improve our skills, establish detailed guidelines and expand our knowledge in the area of minimally invasive surgery,” says Ray Wertheim, MD, FACOG, Director, Minimally Invasive Gynecology Center of Excellence at Inova Fair Oaks Hospital. “We have superb outcomes, we have lowered our complication rate from 9 to less than 3 percent and our patient satisfaction rate has gone through the roof.”

The OB-GYN experts of Inova Fair Oaks Hospital perform 97 percent of gynecologic procedures using a minimally invasive approach, exceeding the national rate of 25 to 32 percent.

“There is not another hospital in the nation that can boast those statistics,” says Leonard Rosen, MD, Chairman of the Robotics Committee at Inova Fair Oaks Hospital. “Inova Fair

Oaks Hospital’s designation as a Center of Excellence truly speaks to the benefits of minimally invasive surgery for women.”

RIGHT PLACE, RIGHT TIME

For Catherine Schmitt, having minimally invasive surgery at Inova Fair Oaks Hospital changed her life. For three years, the 54-year-old elementary school administrative assistant had endured problems associated with a fibroid in her uterus that had grown so large that she could feel it when she went for her daily jog. Though Schmitt felt she could no longer tolerate the pressure in her abdomen, the intermittent bleeding and the accompanying anemia, she was still anxious about having surgery.

Minimally invasive laparoscopic surgery to remove Catherine Schmitt's uterus also took away the fibroid that was causing her so much discomfort. It didn't take her long to feel better. One week after the surgery she entertained eight guests for dinner.

When Schmitt went to see Dr. Wertheim, her anxiety vanished. She and her husband knew they were in capable hands.

"Dr. Wertheim did a wonderful job of giving us clear, solid information about what this procedure would involve," she says. "One of the things that was really key was we talked to Dr. Wertheim on at least three occasions, and he listened to my concerns and helped me understand what the possibilities were."

Dr. Wertheim performed a minimally invasive laparoscopic hysterectomy, which involved removing Schmitt's uterus and the fibroid that had caused her so much discomfort. Schmitt's surgery was done as an outpatient procedure and she went home two to three hours after the surgery. Just one week after the surgery she had eight guests over for dinner.

"It's a great procedure," says Schmitt. "I think the combination of good medical practice, the surgery itself and Dr. Wertheim's phenomenal medical style is what has made it such a great experience."

These days, when Schmitt is not working full-time, she runs, gardens, entertains in her home and spends quality time with her husband and their two sons.

"By removing the uterus and the fibroid, she felt wonderful," says Dr. Wertheim. "She felt no more pelvic pain or pelvic pressure. She can do anything she wants, much better than she did before the surgery."

Schmitt's only regret is not having done the surgery sooner. "If I had known what I knew the day after the surgery, I would have done it three years before," she says.

Minimally invasive procedures offer numerous benefits for women, compared to traditional open surgery. With the minimally invasive approach, women can get back to their normal activities sooner than with traditional open surgery. At Inova Fair Oaks Hospital, patients typically return home four hours after surgery and resume their active lifestyle within two weeks.

"Minimally invasive surgery is safer than open surgery, the recovery is quicker, there's less pain and discomfort and the long-term outcome for the patient is better," says Dr. Wertheim.

INOVA FAIR OAKS HOSPITAL RECEIVES LEAPFROG TOP HOSPITAL SAFETY DISTINCTION

Inova Fair Oaks Hospital just hopped ahead of the competition. Late last year, it received the 2012 Leapfrog Top Hospital distinction, one of the most competitive national hospital quality awards in the country.

"This award is a testament to our ability to provide safe and reliable care to each patient who comes through our doors," says John Fitzgerald, CEO of Inova Fair Oaks Hospital.
