The Red Maple tree has shiny green leaves which turn into a beautiful crimson orange-red in the fall. The leaves are 4-6 inches long with 2 to 5 lobes. Red Maple's wood is used in conjunction with other maples for making furniture. It can also be used to produce syrup or sugars.
